A “known active advocate” of another political party is defined to mean a person who 1) is a delegate to the convention or an officer of another party; 2) is affiliated with another party through an elected or appointed government position or; 3) has made documented public statements specifically supporting by name another political party or its candidates in the same calendar year as the election at which the person will serve as an inspector. “Documented public statements” means statements reported by the news media or written statements with a clear and unambiguous attribution to the applicant.

## Election Inspector Qualifications

- MUST be at least 16 years of age
- Anyone 18 years of age or older MUST be a registered voter in the State of Michigan
- MUST declare a recognized political party affiliation; may not list Independent
- MUST attend mandatory video training every 2 years
- MUST NOT have a felony record or have been convicted of an election crime
- MUST have a W-9 form on file with the township offices
- Minors age 16 or 17 must obtain a yellow CA-7 Form from their school's office to complete with proper signatures\*\*

### \*\* Work Permit required for minors 16 and 17 years of age \*\*

Michigan Law requires all Minors age 16 and 17 to complete a CA-7 State of Michigan Work Permit/Age Certificate. The Minor obtains a yellow CA-7 form from their school's Issuing Officer and completes Section I of the form. Then the Minor submits the CA-7 form along with the Student Election Inspector Application and proper identification to the Township Clerk's Office. The Clerk completes Section II of the CA-7 form and immediately returns the CA-7 form to the Minor to take back to the school for the Issuing Officer's signature and date in Section III. Once signed, the student returns the CA-7 permit to the Township Clerk's Office before applicant can begin work.
